

**NEWS FROM ENGLAND: R. S. Woolhouse, University of York**

A **conference** celebrating the appearance of Leibniz's *New System* in 1695 was organized by **R. S. Woolhouse** and held at the **University of York**, 5-8 July 1995. The opening lecture was given on behalf of the Leibniz Gesellechaft by **Hans Poser**: "L'ordre supérieur de l'âme raisonnable: On the Leibnizian Concept of Soul."
