

IT HAS BEEN ANOTHER GREAT YEAR FOR THE REVIEW. THIS PAST SPRING MARKED THE 10-year anniversary of our Annual Lecture series, and we were privileged to welcome Derek Parfit, who was visiting from Oxford for the semester. Professor Parfit delivered an insightful and stimulating lecture on whether we can avoid the repugnant conclusion, a paradox which he himself identified over thirty years ago. Alongside our biweekly symposia and other events meant to engage the undergraduate philosophy community, we received a record number of submissions, from which our editors selected seven.

In line with our aim of delivering high-quality philosophy to a wide audience, the present volume features a diverse range of articles. Peter van Inwagen, whose seminal work on free will in the 1980's shaped the modern dialogue, offers a series of reflections on the topic in the decades since. Terry Horgan offers new insight into Newcomb's Paradox, and Eric Mandelbaum and Jake Quilty-Dunn reflect on the relationship between belief and reason. Alongside these are pieces spanning a wide variety of topics, from Descartes to political philosophy to weakness of will. We are proud to present this year's volume and hope it has something for everyone.

The Review's success depends on the hard work and generosity of many. First, we are grateful to our trustees, whose financial support and operational guidance contribute significantly to our activities. We are also grateful to the Department of Philosophy for supporting us in many ways, and in particular to our faculty advisors Alison Simmons and Tim Scanlon.
