

## PREFACE

The main theme of this volume 4 of *Eco-ethica* is “Ethics and Politics”. The first two parts are revised papers on this theme from the XXXIII<sup>rd</sup> International Symposium of Eco-ethica which, thanks to professor Mireille Delmas-Marty, was held at Collège de France in Paris from 29<sup>th</sup> of September to 4<sup>th</sup> of October 2014. The third part are new papers devoted to the philosophy of Paul Ricœur (1913-2005), written by Ricœur scholars who have published books on him in the last years. They all focus, in a way or another, on ethics and politics in Ricœur’s thought.

In fact, this journal is not only open to those who have participated in an Eco-ethica symposia, but also to those who write on subjects in the field of eco-ethica.
