Call for Papers Spring 2012

“Principle of Totality and Integrity”

Deadline for Submissions Extended to September 15, 2011

We seek papers that will examine the principle of totality and integrity in all its theoretical and practical aspects. We invite reflections on its place in secular bioethics and in public law as well. Historical studies are also welcome. We are especially interested in the application of this principle to particular cases in medicine.

The following are suggested topics and are not meant to be an exhaustive listing:

- Theoretical inquiries into the nature, origin, or justification of the principle of totality and integrity
- Difficult or enlightening cases of moral dilemmas that can be resolved using the principle
- Misuses or abuses of totality-and-integrity reasoning, in which the principle supposedly justifies what is in fact unjustifiable
- Discussions of the principle as used and developed by well-known ethicists, present and past
- Assessments of criticisms of the principle by secular bioethicists
- Discussions of defects in or limitations to the principle
- Studies of particular applications of the principle to surgery, organ donation, sex changes, sterilization, indirect abortion, and other cases
- Novel proposals for use of the principle to resolve difficult moral quandaries
- Appeals to the principle in decisions handed down in courts of law
- Considerations of the differences between the ideas of totality and integrity, the historical development of these ideas, and their relation to each other
