

***INQUIRY* in Transition: A Note to *INQUIRY* Readers**

In the fall of 2008 *INQUIRY* had fallen on hard times due, in part, to budget cuts in the state of Ohio. At that time Dr. Fasko suggested that *INQUIRY* be moved to Sam Houston State University (SHSU), and we formed the SHSU *INQUIRY* Editorial Group to explore that possibility. Ultimately, four things persuaded us that this venture was worth undertaking. First, when we contacted members of the *INQUIRY* Editorial Advisory Board, many of whom are among the most well-recognized pioneers of the critical thinking movement, we received extremely encouraging replies that they regarded *INQUIRY* as an important outlet for information and perspectives about critical thinking and that they were willing to commit themselves to assisting a reborn *INQUIRY*. Second, SHSU is composed of five colleges, and each of the deans of those colleges was willing to make a financial commitment that would allow *INQUIRY* to pursue its mission of fostering critical thinking across the disciplines. Third, Dr. George Leaman of the Philosophy Documentation Center worked with us to provide new subscribers with a genuinely worthwhile product by allowing subscribers to elect an option that gives them electronic access to previous issues as well as the current issue. Finally, Dr. Fasko volunteered to edit the first two issues of the renascent journal, *INQUIRY* Vol. 25, No. 1 (Spring 2010) and Vol. 25, No. 2 (Summer 2010). We look forward to continuing to work with Dr. Fasko as a member of the Editorial Advisory Board.

It is our goal to make *INQUIRY: Critical Thinking Across the Disciplines* a valuable resource for those of us who are deeply involved in the theory, practice, and pedagogy of critical thinking. We welcome your submissions and your input.
